


Servicing the Fountain

Over time the fountain can become clogged. To clean the filter, lift the fountain off of the flower pad, remove the fountain head and flip the fountain upside down. Next remove the water pump (do not disconnect the wire). Take out the rotor and the filter with tweezers, and clean all exposed parts using warm soapy water. Reassemble the fountain. See drawing below:



Keeping your Bird Oasis Clean

Eventually algae can grow in your bird bath. Preventive measures can greatly reduce the amount of algae and how often your bath needs to be cleaned. When cleaning your Bird Oasis, GENTLY wash the floating flower pad and fountain. Just spray the flowers with water to clean them. After cleaning the fountain and floating flower pad, dump the old water from the barrel, clean with vinegar or bleach and then wash with soapy water. Rinse and refill the tub with fresh water.

Assembly of your Lightscapes Bird Oasis™ Bird Bath

Model No. 104-0001

Tools Needed: None

Parts in the Packaging: 11.9 Gallon Barrel, Solar Powered Fountain, 4 Fountain Clips, 7 Fountain Heads, 1 Fountain Head Base, Floating Flower Pad with Bath Tub.

Step One: Take Items out of box and make sure all parts are included.

Step Two: Place your Bird Oasis™ barrel where you plan on leaving it. Make sure the surface is flat and level and has maximum exposure to sunlight.

Step Three: Fill the barrel to one-half inch below the rim, with clean water.

Step Four: Choose the fountain head you want to use (see next page). Push the head into the center hole on top of the fountain (see photo B. below).

Step Five: Place the four clips at an equal distance apart, onto the plastic side wall of the fountain, push in place using thumb. (see photo A. below).

Step Six: Place the floating flower pad into the water.

Step Seven: Place assembled fountain onto floating flower pad. NOTE the fountain clips rest on top of the flower pad (see photo B. below).





Choosing The Fountain Head

The Bird Oasis comes with seven fountain heads that create different spray patterns. They are easily installed and changed to suit your preference. Fountain heads B1, B2, B3, and B4 install directly onto the fountain. Fountain heads B5, B6 and B7 snaps on to the base B8. Install the fountain heads or the base B8 onto the fountain by pushing it into the center hole on top of the fountain. If you live in a windy area, we recommends using fountain heads B1 or B3.
